



## Step-by-Step Instructions

Hp 932 and HP 933

HP 950 and HP 951



**Items needed: Gloves, syringe, black pigment ink, yellow, cyan, and magenta ink. Review hints & tips and check list at [http://freeink4life.com/support/Quick%20start\\_Guide\\_FI4L.pdf](http://freeink4life.com/support/Quick%20start_Guide_FI4L.pdf).**

**Syringe: Attach needle tip to the syringe tightly. Unscrew lid on ink bottle. Pull plastic stopper out. Dispense the correct color ink into syringe. Rinse syringe and needle tip after every use and before using syringe with another color. Rinse syringe and needle tip with warm water until the water runs clear.**

1. Look at the end of the cartridge for a plastic ball. The ball is plugging up the filling hole.
2. Stand the cartridge on the end where the plastic ball is facing up.
3. Using a “L” screw, put the “L” tool on top of the plastic filling hole ball and tap it with a hammer to knock the plastic ball into the cartridge.
4. Fill the syringe with ink.

**Black will hold approximately 20ml of ink, High Capacity Black cartridge holds up to 40ml.**

**Color cartridge will hold approximately 10ml of ink, High Capacity Color cartridge holds up to 20ml.**

5. Very S-L-O-W-L-Y inject ink into the fill hole. If ink begins to bubble out of the fill hole, stop refilling. Bubbling occurs when a cartridge is either over-filled or if ink is being inserted too quickly. Wait several minutes and then try to slowly insert more ink. If ink begins to bubble out the fill-hole or leak from the print head, you have plenty of ink in the cartridge.



6. Seal the filling hole using the yellow silicone plug in the kit. You can actually cut and mold the plug to fit into the filling hole. Apply pressure when placing the silicone plug into the filling hole this way it is air tight.

Note: On your second refill remove the silicone plug and refill the same way you did the first time.

Note: This cartridge has a chip that knows its manufacturer date.

It lets the cartridge operate and be refilled for two years then it will stop working.

If the cartridge sat on a shelf for 6 months before you bought it then you only have 18 months to use it and refill it as much as you want.

**How to tell how much ink is leaving your bottle:**

**For bottles with needle cap dispensing tip:**

**Holding the bottle upside down, it is 5 mls from the top to the first marker line and then 3 mls each marker line. The bottle has 65mls of ink.**

7. Run 1 -- 3 cleaning cycles as per printer instructions.
